

PORT CHARGES REGULATIONS FOR SHORE POWER SUPPLY AT RENDSBURG DISTRICT PORT

§ 1 Principle

To reduce emissions and promote environmentally friendly energy supply, Rendsburg District Port provides shore power.

The supply is generally provided as:

- 400
- 50 Hz
- Three-phase electrical supply

Billing is on a flat-rate basis according to connected load.

§ 2 Connection options

The following connection ratings are generally available:

- 32 A
- 63 A
- 125 A
- 400 A by request only and subject to availability.

Within the ISPS area, connections of up to 125 A are available.

Powerlock or special connections outside the ISPS area are only possible subject to prior agreement.

§ 3 Shore power charges

Tariff class	Connection	Flat-rate charge (net)	
1	up to 32 A	€90.00	per 24 hours or part thereof
2	32 A - 63 A	€200.00	per 24 hours or part thereof
3	63 A - 125 A	€350.00	per 24 hours or part thereof
4	400 A	Billing exclusively by separate agreement.	

§ 4 Higher usage

If higher connected loads are used or detected than those registered, the vessel will automatically be reclassified into the next higher fee category.

§ 5 Environmental charge for non-use

Where technically available shore power is not used, an environmental charge will be levied.

The environmental charge amounts to	€0.05 net per GRT or metric ton
but at least:	€100.00 net per mooring

The obligation does not apply if:

- use is not technically possible
- safety considerations preclude it
- it can be demonstrated that no suitable connection is available

§ 6 Taxes and duties

All charges are subject to applicable statutory taxes and duties.

Where statutory tax exemptions or preferential treatment apply, only the statutory requirements shall apply.

§ 7 Entry into Force

These fee regulations shall enter into force on 15 July 2026.
